

CARBON TAX B.C. ADJUSTMENT

Subject: Carbon Tax B.C. Adjustment

As of April 1st, 2023, the Canadian Federal government will increase the carbon tax by an additional \$15 per ton to \$65 per ton. This equates to an increase of \$0.144/L for all types of fuel. This is in part of the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act introduced in 2018.

Minimum National Carbon Pollution Price Schedule (2023-2030)

New revenues generated from increasing the carbon tax will be used to:

- Provide carbon tax relief and protect affordability
- Maintain industry competitiveness
- Encourage new green initiatives

Our current method of charging a Motor Fuel Surcharge is to apply the rates posted in the Freight Carriers Association of Canada (FCA) Diesel Fuel Cost Change Index. The FCA index excludes the **B.C. Carbon Tax** costs associated with the type of fuel purchased in B.C. as part of its calculation.

B.C. Gasoline Carbon Tax: 38.05 ¢/litre B.C. Diesel Carbon Tax: 40.51 ¢/litre

Therefore, to ensure transparency CAT will apply this new Carbon Fee April 1, 2023 as follows:

Carbon Fee: 3.5% of Freight Charges

(Will not be charged on Accessorial or Heat Charges)
